

IPAA Scholarship Application

Scholarship Guidelines and Application

One scholarship will be awarded annually, up to a maximum of \$2,000 at the sole discretion of the IPAA Board of Directors.

Instructions –

To be considered for this scholarship award, you must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a High School Senior with an expressed interest in pursuing an aviation degree. Applicant must attach their college, university, or technical college enrollment acceptance letter.
2. Be enrolled in a bachelors degree level Aviation Degree Program at an accredited college or university and plan to continue this pursuit in the following year OR
3. Be enrolled in an associates degree or technical college program pursuing a degree in the aviation field and plan to continue this pursuit in the following year.
4. Be a student that attends a Iowa college or university, a resident of the State of Iowa attending a college or university outside the State, or an active duty service member with an entrance point in Iowa at the time the award is made.
5. Have achieved academic proficiency (grade point average) at the time of the application of 2.5 or better (based on a 4.0 system).
6. Applicant must not have previously received the scholarship from the Iowa Public Airport Association.
7. Applicant must complete all requested information on the scholarship application form. Submission of the form is considered your signature that the application information is accurate and complete.

The information presented on this application will determine your eligibility for this assistance and will also be used as a basis for your ranking. For this reason, it is extremely important that you answer all questions completely and submit all attachments.
