

MASON CITY, Iowa- Mason City could soon have a new connection to one of the largest cities in America. Monday afternoon the Airport Commission sat down to vote on whether to accept one of the two commercial flight services out of the Mason City Airport.

The board agreed to have Air Choice One fly more than a dozen flights out of Mason City Airport each month. Pam Osgood, Manager of the Mason City Airport, says she is excited about the service and hopes the community will be as well.
