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The Office of Rail Transportation will determine if a project involves a railroad and if an agreement is required. They will indicate this in Project Scheduling System (PSS) by selecting Yes for “Railroad Involved” and “Railroad Agreement”, see below for an example.

If a railroad is involved and an agreement required, they will attach a Developmental Specification (DS) for railroad insurance to the project. The Office of Contracts will add the appropriate bid item for the particular railroad(s) involved.

If no action has been taken with the “Railroad Involved” and “Railroad Agreement” options in PSS, contact the [Office of Rail Transportation](#) so they can determine if a railroad is involved.
