K sheets provide overhead (plan) and side (profile) views of interchanges affected by mainline construction or reconstruction. K sheets are very similar to D sheets except the baselines of the ramps are usually shown instead of the mainline.

K sheets also include a full plan of an interchange.

Plan Quality Checklist

General

- Use the D sheet checklist (see Section [1F-5](#)).
- Are Interchanges and ramps presented in order of occurrence?
- Are ramps labeled in the bottom right of the plan view?
- Are tie in elevations shown in profile view?

Full Plan View

- Are equations at tie-ins labeled on plan view?
- For free flow terminals, are there references to appropriate Standard Road Plans or Design Details.
- Are the following areas labeled?
 - Tapers:
 - Taper rate
 - Curve names.
 - Intersection angles.
 - Dimensions.
 - Width:
 - Major roadway
 - Minor roadway
 - Ramps.
 - Median(s)
