Use the following definitions to complete the form. All other definitions are subject to BABA rules in 2 CFR 184 and related Federal guidance:

Product Name: Provide the name of the product as it appears on the product packaging.

Company/Manufacturer Name: Provide the company name as it appears on the product packaging.

Mailing Address: Identify the mailing address for communication regarding products and materials. A P.O. Box is acceptable.

Physical Address: Identify the physical address where the product's production facility is located. If it is the same as the Mailing address, you can enter 'Same as Mailing address'. If it is not physically located in the United States, you may enter 'Foreign' in lieu of the physical address.

Submittal/Certification: This certification needs to be completed by an authorized and knowledgeable representative of the manufacturer.
