MILEAGE

Mileage between Cities and Junctions

HIGHWAY TRAFFIC LEVELS

- PAVED MULTILANE ROADWAYS
- PAVED TWO-LANE ROADWAYS
- Annual Average Daily Traffic (AADT) = 0 to 700
- minimum 4' paved shoulder or bicycle lane*
- AADT = 701 to 1,500
- minimum 4' paved shoulder or bicycle lane*
- AADT = 1,501 to 3,000
- minimum 4' paved shoulder or bicycle lane*
- AADT = more than 3,000
- minimum 4' paved shoulder or bicycle lane*

*Shoulders may contain rumble strips
