

## **Quick Reference Guide: County Issuance of PWD Stickers**

## Vehicle Services

Motor Vehicle Division

INVENTORY

- PWD stickers are ordered from the DOT MVD Online Order site: https://iowadot.iaprisonind.com/motorvehiclediv.aspx
- Password is DOT (case sensitive).
- Keep stickers in a secure area with limited access. Low humidity is ideal.
- Counties will designate staff to issue PWD stickers and maintain inventory.
- Supply on hand should match demand; do not overorder.

ACCESS

- Issuing PWD stickers is an additional permission in ARTS.
- Each county will identify 2-3 people who will have this access.
- Treasurer/Supervisor will submit names to system access indicating that these individuals have been assigned to PWD sticker issuance.
- As counties build their capacity to train others in their county, additional access may be given.
- The request must be submitted through the "ARTS System Access Wizard."
  - o ARTS>Tools>System Access Request>ARTS Access Request
  - The requested change is for PWD sticker issuance.

ISSUANCE

- Required documentation from customer:
  - Completed application.
  - o Doctor's certification of a permanent disability.
  - Veteran verification US DVA certification.
- Vehicle requirements:
  - The applicant is an owner of the vehicle.
  - o The vehicle registration is current.
  - o The vehicle is not a lease or in a trust.
