THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, SERIES 2015, ARE AMENDED BY THE FOLLOWING MODIFICATIONS AND ADDITIONS. THESE ARE SPECIAL PROVISIONS AND THEY SHALL PREVAIL OVER THOSE PUBLISHED IN THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.

1102.01, A.

Replace the fifth sentence:

The statement shall be filed with the Department at least **58** calendar days before the date on which proposals are to be received.

1102.01, F.

Replace the Article:

~~A prospective bidder must complete contract work in the following categories in excess of the quantities listed below before qualification to submit proposals or receive awards for projects involving larger quantities than those listed. The contract work may be done as a contractor or subcontractor. All such completed contract work will be combined into one total for each category to determine the bidder's qualifications.~~

A prospective bidder must submit a project reference list verifying their experience as the erector in successful erection of at least two truss, arch, cable-stayed bridges with steel framing systems containing a span length of at least 350 feet or a steel girder bridge with a span length of at least 500 feet and at least one bridge over a navigable waterway as defined by 33 C.F.R. § 329 (2023). Only one of the two reference projects can be a steel girder with a span over 500 feet. One reference project shall have been completed within the past 10 years. The second reference project shall have been completed within the last 20 years. Provide a brief description of each project with the owner's name and current phone number.

These erector qualifications must be uploaded with the "[Contractor's Financial - Experience - Equipment Statement](#)" (Form 650004) at least 8 calendar days before the date on which proposals are to be received. If bidder is already prequalified by the Iowa DOT in the Bridge Prequalification Category, only the erector qualifications will be required. These can be emailed to the Contracts and Specifications Bureau at dot.contracts@iowadot.us at least 8 calendar days before the date on which proposals are to be received. The Contracts and Specifications Bureau will approve or deny the prospective bidders request within 3 business days following submittal, provided that reference project owners can be reached.
